1. **a monitoring system based on environmental indicators**
 - **No. of studies of carrying capacity and visitor management plans in protected areas**
 - **No. of newly developed sustainable tourism products/services/activities**
 - **No. of sustainable mobility/accessibility strategies targeting tourists as key target groups**
2. **a set of environmental requirements for project proposal**
 - **Adoption of “environmental sustainability by design” approach**
 - **Promoting business networks embedding climate change mitigation and adaptation**
 - **Considering potential impact of infrastructure projects on habitats and species of EU interest in the Natura 2000 network**
 - **Including preventive archaeology procedures in infrastructure projects with potential impacts on Landscape and Cultural heritage**
